

QIAT?

The Quality Indicators for Assistive Technology (QIAT) were designed to provide education organizations with guidance in assessing their current Assistive Technology (AT) processes and plan for improvement of AT services. QIAT (pronounced "quiet") indicators support AT decision-making, align with specific areas of special education processes, describe the core components of quality AT services in eight areas, and require a team approach that emphasizes student and family voice. Supporting materials are available to guide development of effective, efficient, and ethical AT services.

QIAT indicator areas

- Consideration of AT
- Assessment of AT Needs
- Including AT in the IEP
- Implementation of AT
- Evaluation of Effectiveness of AT
- AT in Transition
- Administrative Support of AT Services
- Professional Development and Training in AT

QIAT self-evaluation Matrices

The QIAT Matrices are a guide to collaborative self-assessment of AT services. The information gathered is used to plan for changes that lead to improvement in manageable and attainable steps.
